

#PittsburghTop100 Ohio River Girls Basketball League

1. The ORGBL will follow all rules according to the WPIAL unless stated on this page.
 - a. Coaches are NOT allowed to stand during games.
 - b. 4th Grade is NOT allowed to play zone defense.
2. Quarter length
 - a. 4th Grade = 8 minute running clock.
 - b. 5th & 6th Grade = 6 minutes, regular clock.
 - c. No overtime for 4th grade. If overtime occurs at the 5th and 6th grade level, 2 minutes will be put on clock. Pressing allowed.
3. Pressing rules:
 - a. There is no pressing in 4th grade.
 - b. In 5th grade, teams can press with 2 minutes left in first half and 2 minutes left in second half.
 - c. In 6th grade, pressing is allowed all 2nd and 4th quarters.
 - d. If a team is up by 20 points, no pressing allowed.
4. Mercy Rule: If a team is up by 20 points going into 3rd quarter, then the clock will run unless a time out occurs.
5. Foul shots:
 - a. 4th grade shoots from 2nd hash from the FT line.
 - b. 5th grade they can release from behind line and cross over.
 - c. 6th grade normal.
6. Timeouts are 2 (one minute) per game for all levels. In overtime, each team gets 1. Timeouts do not carry over into OT or OT periods.
7. If both teams are same color, home team wears WHITE/GREY.
8. Home team will be official scorer and pay refs.
9. All home teams will have a laminated copy of this available for all games, which will be read by refs at pregame coaches/players meeting.
